Title: BTA Level 2 Coach.

Current holder/s:	See Coaching List
Type of volunteering	To act as BTA Level 2 Coach for LBT.
Main purpose of volunteering	To conduct coached sessions approved by the head coach.
Responsible to	The head coach, the coach coordinator and the LBT committee.
Competencies / experience required	Must be well-organised, have good communication skills and be correctly qualified. Additional qualifications may be required in order to deliver certain sessions, (juniors, etc).
Commitment required	Delivery of quality coached sessions. Supervision of Level 1 coaches. Attendance at coaches meetings. To be responsible and reliable when coaching.
Benefits to self	Benefit of being a qualified Level 2 coach, leading sessions, assisting and advising other coaches and seeing athletes improving. Working with Level 3 coaches to gain knowledge and experience.
Benefits to community	Provision of high quality coached sessions at all levels.
Support received from:	The LBT chair, club committee, the head coach and coach coordinator. Training opportunities will be available to help the person fulfil this role.
