Title: Referee/Technical Coordinator

Type of volunteering	To act as the Referee and Technical Coordinator on the LBT club committee.
Main purpose of volunteering	To provide advice and support to LBT organisers and club committee regarding events and to liaise with the BTA Rules and Technical Committee re: appointment of referees for major events taking place within the region. On a regional level, to assist with appointing referees to races within the region.
Responsible to	The LBT chairperson and committee.
Competencies / experience required	Be well organised, thorough and have basic knowledge of risk assessment and refereeing in triathlon.
Commitment required	For club and regional committees, occasional 2 hour meetings per year.
Benefits to self	Knowledge that the LBT and regional events are run well and correctly and getting to know the referees and race organisers within your region.
Benefits to community	Benefits of well organised and well run events which have fully qualified referees appointed to them.
Support received from:	LBT chairperson and potentially Regional Development Officer. Training opportunities will be available to help the person fulfil this role.
